Durbe Manor

The Durbe Manor in Tukums is one of the most interesting Classicism style castles in Kurzeme. At this time, the renovated exhibition halls the 1st floor of the manor offers expositions of the interior of countryside manors, however the 2nd floor halls offers various expositions about manor in Latvia in the 19th century. Durbe Manor Park was estabilished during the timefrom 1918 until 1838, when the Count Medem reconstructed the Durbe Manor and improved its surrounding.

Straw workshop and museum

The artworks are made of 100 % ecological materials: straw, dried grass, and other similar environmentally friendly and safe materials. The created characters are unique and made in various sizes. Jaunmoku pils

The Jaunmoku Palace was constructed around 1901 as ordered by the mayor of Riga, George Armitsted, and it served as a hunting castle and summer residence. The project of the castle and the horse stable was designed in 1898 by Wilhelm Bockslaff, making the Jaunmoku Castle into one of the most recognised brick buildings in Latvia. The interior style typical for hunting castles was recreated at the end of the 20th century, however particular attention should be paid to the tile furnaces, one of which was made at the turn of the 19th to the 20th century in honour of the 700 years anniversary of Riga city.

Ķemeri National park and the big Ķemeri bog trail of the large Ķemeri moorland

Kemeri National Park – it is a very versatile territory of 38 165 hectares. Human activity has had relatively small influence on this territory, mainly just in the fishermen's villages and in the agricultural lands in the area of Slampe, therefore the park is the dwelling place for many rare and protected plant and animal species in Latvia and in Europe. Kemeri National Park offers specifically created routes, and the tourists can visit the park with a tourguide from KNP or individually.

The footbridge of the Large Kemeri Moorland (Lielais Kemeru tīrelis) is the most popular site in the Kemeri National park. It allows exploring the raised bog un touched by human activity. A footbridge was built in the moorland using wooden planks. It takes you to a world of moss, bog pines, pools in the marsh, dark lakelets accompanied with the scent of marsh teas. The total lenght of the footbridge is 3 km.
